Highland Park, IL – The City of Highland Park welcomes the **3rd Annual Highland Park Art Walk!**

The Highland Park Art Walk is a juried art exhibition of artwork by Illinois artists presented by the non-profit organization Anatomically Correct. The artwork will be displayed in over 35 downtown Highland Park store front windows throughout the month of June. The participating merchants will also host free art receptions, free children's art activities, special promotions and giveaways throughout the month.
